Students with speech and language impairments face distinctive related literacy challenges. With specific, research based interventions in reading instruction; students with language/learning differences can become proficient readers. This is a comprehensive workshop which presents the theory and practices of the Constable Literacy Procedures as applied in individual, small group and school wide settings across disciplines.

Topics include, the application of speech and science to literacy, a comprehensive model of emergent literacy, a vowel focused continuous production program for decoding and fluency, and an overview of the structure and content of spelling and comprehension strategies. Evidence from research in speech, language, and educational psychology supports the practices discussed. Participants will leave with a broadened framework for understanding literacy. Videotapes and child-made materials will help elucidate the strategies.
